

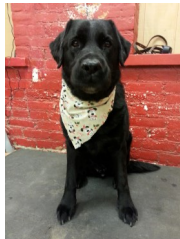

Personal Testimony

I was born with a rare eye condition called Aniridia, which is congenital absence of the iris portion of the eye. After living with this condition since birth, I have become legally blind since 2006. I am able to see, but only things up close appear to be clear. Things farther away are not clear to me. God has blessed me in so many ways. I grew up in a Christian home, so I always felt that my vision impairment was allowed by God to be used to further the kingdom of Christ. It is not a disability, but an inconvenience that I have learned to live with. I believe that God will not allow anything in our lives that we can not handle without His divine help.

I was saved on April 12, 1978 during a revival service at Jonesboro First Baptist Church in Jonesboro, IL. I surrendered my life to full-time ministry at the age of 19 during a revival service at Anna First Baptist Church in Anna, IL.

My life has been far from perfect, but after surrendering to ministry I attended Hannibal-LaGrange Baptist College in Hannibal, MO, where I received my Bachelor degree in Christian Education, with a minor in Church Music, and a second Bachelor degree in Business Administration. In 2015 I went back to college and graduated with my Master's in Substance Use Disorder Counseling from U of I Springfield in May 2016.

I served as pastor of Beech Grove Baptist Church for a total of 5 years. I have always been active in my music ministry. I have a loving and supporting wife, who loves to share in our ministry. She is my eyes to the world around me, when I'm unable to see something.
